# & Tyler A. Wallach

This is the third collaboration from Anthony Misiano & Tyler A. Wallach, and their first time co-directing. In 2018's drama *The Verge* and 2022's comedy *Brute Force*, Anthony served as actor and editor to Tyler's direction. This time around they knew they wanted to build something together from the ground up.

Writer-Director Anthony Misiano is a multi-hyphenate living in New York City. His last three films, *Red Menace, Wendy/Gigi & Part-Time* have won multiple awards at festivals worldwide. He is very meticulous and decisive when it comes to filmmaking and takes his work very seriously, but feels if nobody's laughing on set, something's terribly wrong.

Director-Production Designer Tyler A. Wallach was born to a family of artists, musicians and filmmakers who instilled in him a love for storytelling. He enrolled in the School of Visual Arts while working as a professional set dresser. He's production designed commercials, music videos, feature films and has directed numerous critically acclaimed shorts. In 2015 he founded Red Leaf Film, through which he writes & directs while championing projects by other artists. He's drawn to character driven stories about the daily struggles of ordinary people, whether the outcome is hilarious, harrowing, or more often, a little bit of both.

## Daniel Augustin Executive Producer

Haitian-American actor, artist, director, and producer based in Los Angeles, Daniel Augustin is best known for his role as Maurice on the hip-hop comedy RAP SH!T (Max) created by Issa Rae. He made memorable appearances on ABC's Grey's Anatomy, Wu-Tang: An American Saga (Hulu), and charmed audiences as the adorably hopeless romantic, lan, opposite Hilary Duff in How I Met Your Father (Hulu).

Daniel's work behind the camera began in 2012, most recently directing & producing *Kinfolk: the Series* alongside his long-time collaborator & wife, writer-actor Sh'Kia Augustin. It was officially selected into the 2022 *Tribeca Creators Market* and is currently streaming on YouTube's ToughLoveSeries channel.

On Inheritance, Daniel says, "Anthony's script drew me to this production because I was physically abused as a child, and because I've spent so much money in therapy discussing how my past has haunted my forward progress. I have many colleagues but none like him. I love the guy. He's helped me not just be a better filmmaker but a better human being."





### Josh Turi Special Effects Makeup

Joshua Turi is a 3-time Emmy Award Winning make-up artist and prosthetic designer. Located in Northern New Jersey, he and his company, Designs to Deceive, have been supplying specialty services to the entertainment industry for over three decades.

His work can be seen in Jules (Bleeker street), Knock at the Cabin (M. Night Shyamaln), Dr. Death seasons 1 & 2 (Peacock), White House Plumbers (HBO), Mr. Robot (USA), and much more. Josh spent 15 years as the make up key & lab supervisor for Saturday Night Live (NBC) and 6 years as the prosthetic make up department head for Marvel TV (Netflix). These shows included Punisher, Daredevil, Iron Fist, Luke Cage, Jessica Jones, and The Defenders. His work can also be seen on Broadway. His prosthetics are used in Harry Potter and the Cursed Child, Mrs. Doubtfire, The Lion King and various shows at Lincoln Center.

Joshua says about Inheritance, "I knew I had to be a part of this project. What Anthony wanted to do with the look of the film, and of course, these characters, excited me. I knew that we could really sink our teeth into these characters."
